

The 49th Ordinary Session of the Council of Arab Central Banks and Monetary Authorities Governors

September 17-18, 2025 – Tunis, Tunisia




1. BACKGROUND

The Central Bank of Tunisia is honoured to host the 49th Ordinary Session of the Council of Arab Central Banks and Monetary Authorities Governors. This high-level event, organized in collaboration with the Arab Monetary Fund, will take place in Tunis on Wednesday and Thursday, September 17–18, 2025, and will include a subsequent high-level Roundtable Workshop on “Challenges Facing Central Banks: Exploring Monetary and Fiscal Interactions.”

On behalf of the Arab Monetary Fund and the Central Bank of Tunisia, we have the honor to welcome all esteemed participants to this important gathering.

2. VENUE

The meetings will take place at the **Jasmin Ballroom of the Four Seasons Hotel**, which is located in the affluent Gammarth neighborhood – close to the new Port Marina development. The hotel is just a 20-minute drive to Les Berges du Lac, where most embassies and international offices are located, and 30 minutes to the central business district, known as Tunis City. It’s also 30 minutes to the centuries-old Medina, featuring palaces, mosques and lively souks for shopping.

5. VISA REQUIREMENTS AND TRAVEL DOCUMENTS

All participants traveling to Tunisia must hold a valid passport or legal travel documents with a minimum validity of six (6) months beyond the intended visiting period.

Delegates are advised to check the visa requirements applicable to their nationality. Should a visa be required, participants are encouraged to begin the application process early. A welcome Cocktail will be offered by the Central Bank of Tunisia on September 16th, in the Four Seasons Hotel at 7:30 pm.


7. SOCIAL EVENT

8. WEATHER

September in Tunisia marks the transition from the hot summer to milder autumn, offering a pleasant climate perfect for exploration. Visitors can expect warm temperatures, limited rainfall, ample sunshine, and moderate humidity, with average daytime temperatures ranging between **25°C/77°F and 30°C/ 86°F**.



9. CURRENCY

The official currency in Tunisia is the **Tunisian Dinar (TND)**. Currency exchange services are available at the airport, hotels, local banks and Exchange offices. Major credit cards are widely accepted.

1USD = 2.9 TND

1Euro = 3.3 TND



10. DIAL CODE

International dial code: **+216**

11. POWER PLUGS AND SOCKETS

In Tunisia, the standard voltage is **220 V** and the frequency is 50 Hz. Electrical outlets typically use Type C and Type E plugs (two round pins).
