

SDG GOAL 2, TARGET 2.a & INDICATOR 2.a.1

Indicator 2.a.1 monitors progress in achieving Target 2.a

Indicator 2.a.1: The Agriculture Orientation Index (AOI) for Government Expenditures:

- refers to domestic public flows to agriculture
- compares government's relative contribution to the agricultural sector compared to the sector's contribution to Gross Domestic Product (GDP).



FAO-GOVERNMENT EXPENDITURE ON AGRICULTURE (GEA) QUESTIONNAIRE & INDICATOR 2.a.1

2.a.1 numerator is based on two key aggregates taken from the GEA questionnaire and/or the IMF GFS database – for the highest level of government available




Agriculture Share of Government Expenditure =

Government Expenditure on Agriculture

AOI – What do the Available Data Tell Us?



AOI > 1 means a higher orientation of the government towards the agriculture sector relative to the sector's contribution to the economy.

AOI = 1 means a **neutral orientation** of the government towards the agriculture sector relative to the sector's contribution to the economy.

AOI < 1 means a **lower orientation** of the government towards the agriculture sector relative to the sector's contribution to the economy.



INDICATOR 2.a.1 POLICY USE AND INTERPRETATION

AOI > 1:

- Improvement in agriculture and rural infrastructure;
- Extension services (technical advice, inputs and services supporting production);
- Compensation of lack of private or foreign investment;

AOI < 1:

- Other sectors need higher government intervention than agriculture;
- Private investment and domestic credit flows to agriculture may be adequate;

AOI = 1 may not be the right target for *any* country:

- Difference in: degrees of decentralization; stage of development of agriculture; food insecurity.
- Still provides useful trend analysis, and comparisons between countries with similar agriculture sectors;
